Liverpool Neighbourhood Connections is an amazing not-for-profit organisation that provides relief from poverty and disadvantage as well as training programs to help women to get ahead. During my visit I was amazed by the success of the Embedding Entrepreneurship Education [EEE] project, which sponsors TAFE courses for women while also providing free childcare services to ensure their studies can be fully undertaken.
